ACCOUNTABILITY TO VISION STATEMENT

The high impact of economic growth needs to be appropriately managed in order to minimize the impact on the quality of life of citizens, protect the existing infrastructure, minimize the environmental impact and ensure the safety of the traveling public.

POLICY STATEMENT

To accommodate the resource industry, this policy allows for the development and use of roads within Flagstaff County through the implementation of road use and construction agreements.

This policy addresses road use conflict and assists in the management of the environmental and liability risks associated with the resource industry access.

The resource industry may be required to enter into road use and/or construction agreements prior to accessing a new or existing facility. The authority to negotiate and approve these agreements is delegated to the Municipal Services Director.

DEFINITION

Resource Industry: Refers to sectors associated with value-added processing facilities, intensified farming operations, high through-put grain elevators or natural resource exploration/development.
