### ACCOUNTABILITY TO VISION STATEMENT

Quality of life and economic prosperity are enhanced through the safe movement of people, goods and services.

### POLICY STATEMENT

In order to ensure the safety of the public and manage risk, Flagstaff County will have consistent design and placement standards for approaches.

Construction of approaches off primary and secondary highways require Alberta Transportation approval.

Each quarter section of land will be provided one approach, at no cost, where there is no existing approach. If additional approaches are approved by Flagstaff County, the landowner is responsible for the costs of the construction of each such additional approach.

The Transportation department is authorized to undertake for construction of approaches on private property, providing such service is at the request of landowners.

Submissions will be reviewed by Municipal Services and scheduled based on resource availability.

Approach access for resource or commercial purposes is not the financial responsibility of the County.
