Council Highlights



Regular Council Meeting of December 10, 2025

Council Highlights briefly identify decisions made by Council. Council encourages its residents, businesses and stakeholders to keep in touch with Council news.

2025 Accounts Receivable — Uncollectible (December)

Council approved the write-off of the outstanding accounts 4921 and 2000 for a total amount of \$2,509.45.

2024-25 PERC Application

Council confirmed that the outstanding taxes in the years 2024 and 2025 for the following companies have been expensed as a bad debt:

- Alpha Bow Energy Ltd. - \$1,639,875.33;
- Pismo Energy Ltd. - \$83,973.55;
- Blue Sky Resources Ltd. - \$329,355.81;
- Cleo Energy Corp - \$386,046.48;
- Long Run Explorations - \$558,522.87;
- Revitalize Energy Inc. - \$1,617.84;
- Westdrum Energy - \$12,224.14.

And further that an application be made for the Provincial Education Requisition Credit (PERC) and Designated Industrial Requisition Credit (DIRC) on the above properties with the understanding that upon collection of any of the above taxes Flagstaff County is obligated to remit the appropriate education property tax to the Alberta School Foundation Fund:

- 2024 PERC - \$215,536.76;
- 2024 DIRC - \$6,669.93;
- 2025 PERC - \$203,985.98;
- 2025 DIRC - \$4,627.55.

Request to Cancel Penalty Account — Owner 11393

Council respectfully denied the request for the cancellation of the penalty levied on roll numbers 146600, 146700, 146900, 147100, 147200, 147300, 167200, 169500, 169600, 169700, 169800, 170300, 170900, 171000, 171600, 171700, 171800, 190300 in the total amount of \$1,102.11.

Regional Subdivision and Development Board — Appointment of Members

Council appointed John Lundy and Howard Shield to the Flagstaff Regional Subdivision and Development Appeal Board for a three (3) year term expiring in December 2028.

Intermunicipal Assessment Review Board — Appointment of Members

Council appointed Howard Shield and Steven Gratrix to the Intermunicipal Assessment Review Board for a three (3) year term expiring in December 2028.

2026 Flagstaff Regional Solid Waste Management Budget

Council approved the proposed 2026 Flagstaff Regional Solid Waste Management Budget with a total municipal requisition of \$1,260,000 (overall decrease of 2.92% from 2025) distributed on a per capita basis to each member, and with Flagstaff County's total requisition being \$451,002.04.

Battle River Alliance for Economic Development (BRAED) Committee

Council defeated a motion to withdraw from the Battle River Alliance for Economic Development (BRAED) committee effective January 1, 2026.
